SANTO DOMINGO. Officials of the Dominican Football Federation (Fedofútbol) will launch on Thursday a triangular, teams to take part will be the Dominican U-17 and U-20 women's national teams, as well as the Omega Select Black team from the United States.

Osiris Guzmán, President of the Fedofútbol, reported that these encounters of blanks are carried out as a basis for preparation of the upcoming international commitments of the local teams.

Guzman pointed out these matches blanks are carried out with the support of companies Orange Dominicana, Coca-Cola, Powerade, Brugal, Miderec and C & A, technicians and Associates (TIASA).

He indicated that the selection U-17 form part of the Group D, together with Aruba and Jamaica, in the heats that is played in the country days 24, 26 and next stage pan, San Cristóbal, August 28 in the face of women's u-17 World Cup to be held in 2012.

Meanwhile, the selected U-20 will take part in the women's Olympics to be held from January 19-28, 2012 in Canada.

Thursday, the u-17 team will play at 4: 00 in the afternoon, against Omega Select Black, on Friday the team U-20 and U-17 will face off and on Saturday, the U-20 team will play Omega Select Black. All matches will be at the Pan American in San Cristóbal Stadium.
